ENROLMENT FEE

A non-refundable enrolment fee of \$300 is required to secure a place at IDEA.

ANNUAL FEES

Program and Resource Fee

Fees cover core program expenses.

Other Fees and Charges

While IDEA endeavours to minimise additional expenses, families may incur costs in addition to the program tuition and resource fee for activities such as camp, excursions and Gala. Students will be offered the opportunity to opt in or out of these non-essential activities; however, every attempt will be made to ensure all students have access.

Discounts

A discount of 4% is applicable to:

- all fees paid in full in time for the invoice due date in Term 1 each year.
- 2nd and subsequent sibling fees when enrolments coincide. This concession will be adjusted when a sibling leaves IDEA. A student on a scholarship will not receive any additional sibling concessions.
- low-income families upon request. Proof of income and assets will be required.
